Description

This is an unusual shape early Victorian jug hallmarked for London 1844 with the silversmiths mark for Joseph Angell I & Joseph Angell II – it also shows the retailers mark for 'J.Mayer, Goldsmith, 68, Lord St, Liverpool'. It measures 5 1/4" (13 cms) tall x 5 1/4" (14 cms) across including the handle x 3 3/4" (9.5 cms). It weighs 294.5 grams and is in excellent condition (any marks you can see are just reflections). It has an engraved squirrel and bird either side of a cartouche on both sides one of which is empty and the other has a crest engraved in it. The front and back of the jug show decoration of a stag and bull surrounded by trees and leaves. Free worldwide fully insured shipping included in the price.
