Interesting early C20th French tooled leather-bound book-table with inset silk-work top. Gilt-tooled brown leatherbound wooden table of shaped 'crescent' form fitted with damask silk-lined central cupboard and drawer with open compartments either side probably for books. The top inset with a glass panel covering a finely-worked silk embroidered picture depicting a central basket of flowers.. The whole raised on a shaped 'os-de-mouton' style legged base. The door and cupboard fitted with brass handles. Elaborately tooled and gilded work to all the leather surfaces. Minor wear to leather and some minor historic wood worm holes (treated).
