Description

Early C19th Regency period mahogany framed pier mirror of architectural inspiration. Compact sized oblong pier mirror retaining its original silver-grey mercury plate which has achieved an atmospheric distressed and 'foxed' patination. The stepped architectural pediment of inverted break-front form, with carved ovolo or 'egg and dart' edge. The underside with carved circular applied decoration. The flamed mahogany panel above the mirror plate with satinwood cross-banded detail with reel turned dividing bar below. Upright 'rope-twist' columns flank the plate with turned ebonised sections to top and bottom. The mirror plate with an ebonised and reeded slip surround. The base with applied circular patera detail. In good original condition throughout with an excellent rich patination and original polish and surface. H 33" W 22" D 4" England c. 1815
