Hinged on one side the lid opens and closes perfectly. When opened clear hallmarks are visible on the inside lip of the Vesta for the Birmingham Assay Office, with a date mark for 1905 and the Lion Passant indicating sterling silver, along with the silversmith's maker's mark for Cornelius Desormeaux Saunders & James Francis Hollings (Frank Shepherd). An unusual Vesta feels lovely to hold in the hand. Condition: Great antique condition. Hallmarks and maker's marks: Birmingham 1905 by Cornelius Desormeaux & James Francis Hollings (Frank Shepherd).
