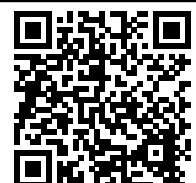

The hinged lid fits well and once opened reveals the original silk and velvet lining. The velvet raised platform to the rear has three cut-outs for three rings. The interior of the lid is lavishly gilded. The box is fully hallmarked for Birmingham 1912 together with the makers mark for the top-notch silversmith, Mappin & Webb.
