Brass capped hood columns and mahogany inlaid panel above and below the trunk door. An arched painted dial with church ruin scenes to the arch and corners. A seconds dial and date aperture. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. This has a great provenance with the label to the case backboard and a stamp inside the trunk door. John Mallett (and son) worked in Barnstaple from 1811 to 1856. They are well documented in Ponsfords' 'Devon Clocks and Clockmakers book'.
