The solid mahogany fall opens to reveal a black leather writing surface with a well fitted interior which has 8 pigeon holes and 4 small drawers and 2 large with 2 brass ring pulls. The centre with 2 pillar pull out tall drawers and a boxwood inlaid door which opens to a further 3 small drawers. This top quality piece of Georgian period furniture has a wonderful original colour and patina and stands on it's original offset ogee shaped bracket feet.
