The cabinet stands on a base that has square tapering legs that are joined by a platform that is of a concave shape to the front and has a deep crossbanding around the edge. This cabinet is splendid with the major surfaces with fine inlaid marquetry. The base section is fitted a pair of drawers. The top glazed display section consists of a pair of straight opening doors with bow shaped glass to each end. The lined interior is fitted 2 shelves. This cabinet was made in 2 parts and so is easy to transport around and into your home. It is a fine cabinet for display as the glass does not have glazing bars that may obscure the contents, and so your collection can be displayed beautifully 186cms high 73ins 109cms wide 43ins 46cms deep 18ins.
