French Sterling Silver & Vermeil Monstrance 1840 decorated with cherubs. This beautifully Baroque Sterling Silver Monstrance is French, it dates from the 1840s, the rays of the radiant sun are typically 19th century French design, these and the Lamb of God decoration are in Vermeil (18k Silver-gilt). There is more elaborated decoration with Wine, Water, and cherubs and at the base the name of Yahveh. The piece is in excellent condition for a piece of this age. Base, cross, luna and a ray of sunshine are stamped with the French "Minerva" silver mark 950-1000. The Cross is stamped by the maker's mark: André Michel. The Luna is stamped with the maker's mark: Jean Baptiste Garnier. FN64. Weight of the monstrance: 695 grams 22,34 Troy Oz. Height of the monstrance: 55,7 cm 21,93 inches. Diameter of the radiant sun: 27,5 cm 10,82 inches.
