Description

Very handsome early 19th.c. mahogany sideboard c.1820. Deep serpentine shaped single piece mahogany top with a rosewood crossbanded edge and ebony and boxwood stringing. Over a long centre drawer flanked with two small drawers to the left and a cupboard to the right. Also serpentine fronted with beautifully figured flame mahogany veneers crossbanded and inlaid to match. Retaining the original gilded brass handles. With a shaped apron below the centre drawer and raised on tapering square legs ending in a moulded spade foot front and rear. Solid mahogany sides and oak drawer linings. Repairs toward the rear edge of the top, otherwise excellent colour and condition, cleaned and polished in our workshops. Dimensions: width 72½", height 36", depth 29".
