The round funnel bowl is engraved with a hunting scene including fox hounds, John Peel blowing his horn and his horse Dunny. The opposite is engraved Dye Ken John Peel. The elegant stem features a teared ball knob with cushion knobs above and below. A conical foot with a rough pontil supports the piece. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown and engraved around the time of John Peel's death in 1854, the fame of Peel is owed to a song written in his honour, of which the name is engraved on this glass D'ye Ken John Peel.

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
