Description

Silver antique Thommen Revue pocket watch, c1910s. The watch has a signed stem-winding movement which is working nicely. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover upon which are engraved details of the movement. The watch measures 50mm diameter excluding the winding stem and the loop. The case is 800 silver with rose gold wash detail, known as a galonne case. Overall the condition is very nice with just one small "ding" to the side. The lens is in good condition. The white enamel double sunk dial is in beautiful condition and has charming ornate hands (one of the hands is a later replacement but of the correct period). The watch will be sent in a new presentation box. In 1859 Gédéon Thommen and Louis Tschopp purchased Société d' Horlogerie à Waldenbourg, a watch manufacturing company set up to provide employment for the locals. A new railway was built but it bypassed Waldenbourg and effectively cut the factory off from the commercial centres. Gédéon Thommen funded 'Waldenburgerbahn', a steam train which connected the valley's villages. Tschopp subsequently left the company and the company was renamed Gédéon Thommen's Uhrenfabriken, and it beca...
