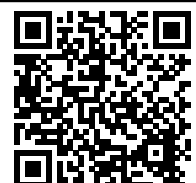
Description

Hubert Robert (22 May 1733 – 15 April 1808) was a French painter, noted for his landscape paintings and capriccio, or semi-fictitious picturesque depictions of ruins in Italy and of France. "A true man of the Enlightenment and one of the greatest creators of poetic images, Hubert Robert followed a remarkable artistic path that led him from Rome in the mid-18th century to the French court, where he produced some of the most spectacular decors in the brilliant decade that preceded the Revolution" Source - The Louvre Dimensions - 82 cm x 60 cm
