Period of Victoria. **Condition** Excellent, age-related wear as shown. **Dimensions** Height: 9.9cm Rim diameter: 5.4cm Foot diameter: 5.8cm. **Weight** 772 grams combined **Technical Description** A set of six cut and engraved 19th century port wine glasses. A bucket bowl decorated with slice, cross-cut diamond and slanting blaze cuts. This rests upon a stem with a facet cut ball knob. The supporting foot is finished with a radial cut foot. Rare to find a complete set of six. **Historical Relevance** Hand-made around the time Queen Victoria married her cousin Prince Albert of Saxe-Coburg and Gotha in the Royal Chapel at St James's Palace.

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
