Description

A magnificent small 'tubreh' - a bag for containing spindles, tent-pegs and other small items - made by Qashqa'i nomads circa 1900. The face of the bag is in beautiful soumak weave and the back in plain-weave. Around the sides and base has been sewn a band of goat-hair to keep the bag secure and small tufts of coloured wool tied in to add decoration and provide good luck. A rare and beautiful example of Qashqa'i weaving. Size: 43cm x 33cm (1' 5" x 1' 1").
