Has achieved a rich glowing patination and colour . In excellent condition. The underside of the top with one historic replaced bearer. A rare miniature table of pleasing scale and design. One minor historic but but stable repair to one leg from column .Would work well to hold a single glass of wine or whisky next to a comfortable chair . H 14" W 10" D 10" England c. 1800
