Beautifully realised in layers of carved shell, mother of pearl and bone to stand in high relief against the black lacquered ground. Presented in the original red lacquered oval frames also painted with cherry blossom. Good condition with only minor wear. Dimensions: width 21", depth 2½", height 28".
