## Description

1920s Cyma Admiral full hunter pocket watch. The watch has a nicely jewelled Swiss stem-winding movement signed Admiral, calibre 998, which is working well. The movement is protected by an inner hinged cover. Cyma was founded by two brothers, Joseph and Theodore Schwob, in 1862. In 1892 they decided to go into partnership with Frédéric Henri Sandoz, owner of Henri Sandoz et Cie. The Cyma name was officially registered in 1903. Sandoz used the most modern of manufacturing processes and produced very high quality time-pieces, trademarked as Tavannes, Cyma and Cyma Tavannes. Their excellent reputation for quality meant that by 1910, Tavannes / Cyma were one of the largest Swiss watch manufacturers in existence. State, or Stayte, was one of the brand names used by the company. The watch measures 50.8mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the loop. The case is gold plated and is the Star model made by the Dennison Watch Case Company. It is in nice condition with just light surface marks from use. The watch has an old watch paper in the back from John Hudson, Alexandria. The winding crown pushes in to open the front cover. Inside the lens is in nice condition. ...
