Blue steel hands and a date aperture and seconds dial. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. The Morgan family of clockmakers from Bristol are noted makers. Thomas Morgan worked at Broad Weir, Bridewell Lane, High Street and Merchants Passage from 1761-1838.
