Date & Origin Baccarat, France, c1835. Period of Louis-Philippe I the Citizen King. **Condition** Some minor grazing to the cuts and chips to the base of the stopper as shown. **Dimensions** Height: 26cm Diameter: 12.5cm. **Weight** 1419 grams **Technical Description** An early 19th century Baccarat Moulé a Feuilles decanter. The neck features three facet cut applied neck rings. The moulded body is further decorated with cutting. A moulded base with a polished pontil completes the piece.
