The tapered body is engraved with a large elaborate wreath containing the initials CF, the body also features an applied handle with an air column within. A polished pontil completes the piece. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown around the time the first rugby international was played in Edinburgh, resulting in a 1-0 win by Scotland over England on the 27th of March 1871.
