The scallop cut rim has a pulled pouring section and leads to a prism cut neck. The body diamond and fan cut and has an applied handle, featuring slice and notch cuts. The piece rests upon a polished base. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown around the time the Irish Royal Navy captain, Edward Bransfield landed on the mainland of Antarctica.
