Period of George III. **Condition** The inside of the bowl is scratched and there is a 5mm chip on the foot. **Dimensions** Height: 19.4cm Rim diameter: 6cm, Foot diameter: 7.1cm. **Weight** 184 grams **Technical Description** Engraved 18th century opaque twist ale glass. An elongated round funnel bowl rests upon a double series opaque twist stem. Engraved hops and barley in saltire decorate the bowl. The stem is comprised of a multi-ply spiral band outside corkscrew. A conical foot with a rough pontil supports the piece. **Historical Relevance** Hand-blown around the time Edinburgh City Chambers was opened as the Royal Exchange, to the design of the Scottish Architect John Adam.
