The Violinist is wearing a full tiered dress made by using a fine holed lace dipped in white glaze and rippled to reproduce the creases in the dress. The overall condition is good, although being such a delicate item, there are a few tiny bits of the dress missing and the tip of the violin bow needs to be glued, otherwise there are no major defects.
