Rare set of George III period balances; the brass pans hung from a steel scale balance inscribed 'WILLIAMS, LONDON'. With two sets of six brass nesting-weights in the original baize-lined mahogany box with a cleated lid and brass lock-and-key. *T.Williams, scale and balance maker, worked at 71 Cannon Street, London from 1783.
