Victorian burr walnut bonheur du jour This magnificent Victorian burr walnut bonheur du jour with Jasperware panels was made circa 1860 in one of the best workshops of the period. This type of furniture is like items that were commissioned for Osbourne House, Queen Victoria's home in the Isle of Wight. The writing table has its original leather inset writing surface. The top has a superstructure consisting of a pair of cupboards to each side of a panelled mirror. The mirror was there to reflect light to the work area. The cupboard doors with the lovely oval jasperware oval panels (probably by Wedgewood) with gilt brass beading. The base with mahogany lined drawers set around the kneehole, all are fitted with the original segmented turned knob pull handles. It stands on end supports that are joined by a turned pole stretcher. The end supports with fine carving.
