The proportional dividers at the front might not be original as they are brass but fit perfectly. Contained within the tray are a beautiful pair of beam compasses. Under the tray there are a couple of curved templates, an ebony and brass parallel rule plus a few other bits and pieces. It is hard to find these comprehensive sets that haven't been mucked about with.
