A Georgian period Nottinghamshire longcase clock. A well proportioned oak case with a caddy top surmounted by original gilded wooden ball finials. Gilded hood capitals to the front and rear. An arched trunk door with original outside hinges. A brass and silvered dial with corner spandrels, date and seconds with blued steel hands. An 8-day duration mechanism striking the hours on a bell. William Barnard of Newark is recorded in Baillies' 'Watchmakers and Clockmakers of the World' book as working until 1784 and born in 1707. This example dates to circa 1760. Height 7ft 5" / 226 cm Width (at widest point of hood) 21 / 54 cms Depth 11" / 26 cms.
