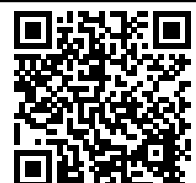
Description

Gents 9ct wrist watch from J W Benson, 1958. The watch has a good quality Swiss ETA movement, signed J W Benson, which is working nicely. The watch measures 34mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the lugs. The bubble back case is 9 carat gold and there are hallmarks inside the case back for Birmingham 1958 together with the case maker's mark for Aaron Dennison, a prolific manufacturer of cases for various watch makers, and also the J W Benson mark. The case is in lovely condition and the shaped lugs are a particularly charming feature. The lens is in lovely condition. The signed dial is in good original condition, perhaps a little discolouration but nothing too serious at all. J W Benson originated in 1847, founded by James William Benson and Samuel Suckley Benson. They were regarded as one of Victorian London's most prestigious retail jewellers and they also manufactured their own watch movements. The company flourished and proudly boasted an elite client base made up of both British and European royalty and a selection of well heeled industrialists and business figures including the King of Siam, the King of Portugal, the King of Denmark, the Emperor ...
