A finely gilded petite sonnerie small cartel wall clock by Jean Godde of Paris. Floral ribbons to the top with pineapple for the winder. An enamel plaque to the base signed 'Jean Godde L'Étoile Paris'. Paste stones to the bezel surround and fine gilt hands to the floral chased dial. Pull repeating quarter striking mechanism by the chain cord below 6 position. An 8-day duration large watch type mechanism striking on 2 gongs on demand. The Godde family of clockmakers are a noted family of makers working from 1691 to the early 20th century. This example dates to circa 1900.
