The makers mark (the Napoleonic Bee) is engraved on the underside of frame and the case is also lucky enough to have an embossed Bee on the push button closure on the front of the leather case. Even the Mother of Pearl eye pieces have the bee engraved and inked together with the signature of this eminent maker. The original case is lined in a vibrant purple silk, the leather has been professionally polished, some wear one side of the handle but intact.
