One is titled "A peaceful evening in the harbour, Anglesey" signed and titled verso, the other "Waiting low tide, Anglesey". There is one old repair to one frame, see images. Joseph Hughes Clayton exhibited from 1891-1929 and was an artist who painted both oil and watercolours, mainly coastal scenes from the North West and North Wales.

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
