Description

This extremely rare torba has only 4 guls instead of the customary 6,9 and 12 gul torbas more commonly seen. The field of the torba is in an early aubergine colour with a very spacious field incorporating the 4 Yomut - Karadashli guls, and can be dated to the early 19th century. The ivory border is also rare with that amazing 'scarab' symbol all the way round. The torba face is in complete condition with no repairs, albeit, its plain-woven back is long gone! Size: 89cm x 40cm (2' 11" x 1' 4").
