9ct gold wrist watch from Garrard, 1957. The watch has a 17-jewel hand-winding movement which is working nicely. The watch measures 31mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the lugs so it would suit a man with a slimmer wrist (or a very wearable watch for a lady). The case is 9 carat gold and there are hallmarks inside the case back for Birmingham 1957 with a case maker's mark for Aaron Dennison, the prolific case manufacturer who supplied various watch makers with cases. The back of the watch has an inscription from Dunlop. The front of the watch is in good condition. The back has a scratch, and some unevenness. The lens is in good condition. The signed dial is in its original finish with original blued steel hands, a subsidiary seconds dial and outer minute markers. A new leather strap has been fitted. The watch will be sent in a new presentation box. Garrards was founded in 1735 by George Wickes. They designed, manufactured and retailed luxury jewellery, silver and watches. The company is still trading today and as well as having their headquarters in Mayfair, London, they also have a presence in Harrods, London, Geneva, Lebanon, Qatar, Dubai, Mo...
