A superior, Edwardian, solid silver double Sovereign Case of the finest quality. The lozenge shaped case is a lovely plain polished silver with no engraving or embossing to the exterior. It has a spring loaded hinged lid, opened by a push button, and has a loop to one side for attachment. When the lid is open two sovereign compartments are visible where partial hallmarks on both of the compartment rims are clear and crisp, with a fabulous neat engine turned pattern engraved to the centre pieces (see images). Hallmarks to the underneath of the lid are also visible for the Chester Assay Office with a date mark for 1902 and Lion Passant indicating the finest sterling silver along with the maker's mark: William Neale. The superb craftsmanship of the silver maker is very evident. The case is in excellent antique collector's condition. It opens and closes perfectly. Hallmarks and maker's marks: Chester 1902 by William Neale. Measurements: Height: 1.5 cm approx. Width not including loop: 5.8 cm approx. Depth: 3.3 cm approx. Weight: 32.8 grams approx.
