The portrait is housed in a 19th century gilt frame (probably original) The size overall is 82 cm x 98 cm (H) and the painting is 61 x 74 cm The frame and painting are in very good condition Spencer Perceval Spencer Perceval KC (1 November 1762 – 11 May 1812) was a British statesman who served as Prime Minister of the United Kingdom from October 1809 until his assassination in May 1812. Perceval is the only British prime minister to have been murdered. He was also the only Solicitor General or Attorney General to become Prime Minister. George Francis Joseph [1762-1812] George Francis Joseph ARA (1764 – 1846) was an English portrait painter. He was born 25 November 1764, and became a student at the Royal Academy in 1784. In 1813 he was elected an Associate of the Academy. He practised in London until 1836, when he retired...
