Good original patination and colour to the case. A brass dial with corner engraving and blued steel hands. Engraved to the dial 'Dent 4 Royal Exchange, Cornhill London'. A double fusee mechanism striking the hours on a gong and engraved Dent to the backplate. A pendulum transporting lock. Circa 1895. The Dent family of clockmakers are most famously known for making 'Big Ben' in Westminster, London. They also had Royal warrants including Queen Victoria.
