The mirror hinged between mould faced uprights, topped with acorn finials. The box base outward swept, cross banded, and strung with line inlay, to the top, and long drawer. The drawer with good oak liners and mounted with axe head brass handles and a key hole escutcheon plate. The whole raised up on shaped bracket feet.
