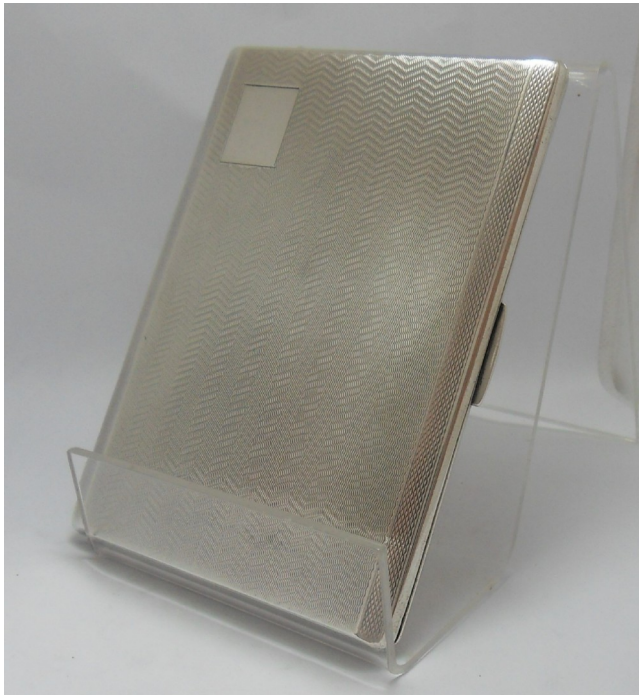

Description

A very fine, art deco, solid silver Cigarette Case, clasped and hinged on one side, when the button is pushed the Case flips open. The exterior of the case is decorated with a dapper herringbone design with a rectangular shaped empty cartouch in one corner. When opened a gilded interior is revealed with an original elastic band for holding in the cigarettes. The clear and crisp hallmarks are visible on the inside of the lid for the Birmingham Assay Office with a date mark for 1946 and Lion Passant indicating sterling silver. The silversmith's mark is also visible: Frederick Field. A good solid case in heavy gauge silver and in great antique condition (There are some superficial scratches to the outside surface of the case commensurate with the age of the item which we mention for accuracy only.) Hallmarks and maker's marks: Birmingham 1946 by Frederick Field. Measurements: Height: 11.3 cm approx. Width: 8.5 cm approx. Depth: 1 cm approx. Weight: 156.6 grams approx.
