Highest quality early 19th century Georgian mahogany 4 tier whatnot of a very useful size. This whatnot has been made from the very best of timbers by one of the best firms of the time, possibly Gillows. The timber in the thin shelves is superb and there are no cracks. All the edges of the shelves have an applied double reed moulding which carries on all round on all four sides. The ball and cup finials to the top are superb as are all the turnings. The whatnot has a drawer to the base which is cock beaded and has its original brass knobs, the drawer linings are all ash. The whatnot terminates in nice shape legs with lovely original brass castors. The piece is in first class condition with no damage and no repairs and retains its original finish and patination.
