Inside, the case is sectioned and lined with green felt. This is worn in places and has faded over the years but overall it displays well. It is in excellent condition for its age and has been well looked after. There are signs of age and use and it has developed a wonderful rich patina. There are surface marks and light knocks and a small piece missing from the underside (see photo) but no splits or major damages.
