Description

A 1920s stem winding pocket watch by Tavannes, with double albert. The watch has a nice quality jewelled Swiss stem-winding movement which is working well. The movement has been identified as Tavannes and is the same movement which normally carries the Stayte brand. Cyma was founded by two brothers, Joseph and Theodore Schwob, in 1862. In 1892 they decided to go into partnership with Frédéric Henri Sandoz, owner of Henri Sandoz et Cie. The Cyma name was officially registered in 1903. Sandoz used the most modern of manufacturing processes and produced very high quality time-pieces, trademarked as Tavannes, Cyma and Cyma Tavannes. Their excellent reputation for quality meant that by 1910, Tavannes / Cyma were one of the largest Swiss watch manufacturers in existence. State, or Stayte, was one of the brand names used by the company. The watch measures 48.2mm diameter excluding the winding crown and the loop. The case is gold plated and is the Scepter model made by the Star Watch Case Company. The case is in good condition with just light surface marks and mild bruising to the back nothing serious at all. The acrylic lens is in nice condition. The white enam...
