A small early 18th Century bureau constructed from beautifully figured walnut veneers. The cross banded and subtle chevron inlaid fall with shaped brass escutcheon. The baised lined fall opens to reveal a well flitted interior consisting of 6 pigeonholes, 4 short and 2 long drawers with axe head handles and central door all inlaid with boxwood stringing. The 4 graduated and cross banded drawers all with conforming chevron inlay and brass handles and escutcheons. The whole raised on a cross grain off set moulding and shaped bracket feet.
