With its original stopper and showing an array of slice, facet, fan and diamond cutting it is a superb example and one of the very few we have seen in the last 16 years. **Historical Relevance** The 1910 World Missionary Conference, or the Edinburgh Missionary Conference, was held on 14 to 23 June 1910 with 1215 representatives from around the world.
