Description

A pair of William & Mary High Back Chairs, circa 1700, the cane panel backs with scroll carved cresting and flanked by barley twist columns over caned seats raised on barley twist and scroll carved supports. The chairs have been restored at some point (probably in the 19th century), and are in stable condition for chairs of this type, one of the chairs has been strengthened by corner brackets to the underside of the seat and has had a small section wood cut into the back to the seat where the cane joins the seat rail. The caning to both seats has been replaced during the past restoration and also the cane to one of the back panels is an old replacement. 138cm high, the seats 44cm wide at the front, 40.5cm deep and 50cm high.
