The arched top with dental moulding over fine blind carved rococo tracery, over arched dial with strike - silent flanked by two serpent spandrels & with very fine engravings. The main dial cornered with rococo spandrels, silvered chapter ring with Roman inner and arabic outer. The centre with further engraving, date aperture & scalloped seconds dial, silvered and engraved with a Tudor rose. Steel hands. The trunk door with a crossbanded border. Original lead weights and brass pendulum bob. All in good original condition, fully serviced and guaranteed for one year. This is a well finished and solid clock, keeping good time.
