The stylish stand has a gadrooned border, four feet and is also fully hallmarked on the base, inkwell holders and lids. This beautiful silver desk stand is by William Hutton & Sons, dates from 1907, looks great on display and is a good useable desk accessory. Material: Silver. Hallmarked: The desk stand and both inkwells are hallmarked for Sheffield, date letter P for 1907 and with the maker's mark for W.S.Hutton & Sons. Country of Origin: UK. Date: 1907.
