Description

Early C19th French Charles X period marble-topped mahogany pier or console table of small proportions . Smart flame-mahogany veneered console table with inset mirror back , the 'cavetto' shaped frieze fitted with a concealed drawer. Raised on a shaped-front plinth platform base with projecting ends , carved 'split' paterae detail to the terminals and supported on scroll-form cabriole uprights and mounted on unusual turned and tapered bun-type feet . The original thick rounded-corner variegated marble slab top of an unusual colour and with distinctive striations . Fitted with the original mercury-silvered inset mirror-plate , the frieze drawer with book-matched veneers. The reverse fitted with the original boards. Useful small-scale pier or console table for a hall-way or drawing room . In excellent original condition with a rich colour and patina. H 37" D 15" W 28" France c.1830
