A fine example of a Georgian sterling Silver decanter label for "Rum". The label is a rectangular shape with a reeded border hanging on a silver chain. It is good quality and well made, weighing approximately 9g and measuring 4cm long x 2cm wide. It is hallmarked for Thomas Phipps & Edward Robinson. It carries the Georgian head but no date letter. However the makers can be found to be registered between 1790-1805. It is in excellent condition with a clear hallmark. There are no damages and it displays beautifully. There are some faint surface marks and signs of age but nothing detrimental. It has been gently cleaned and polished and is ready for use.
