It is fully hallmarked for George Nathan & Ridley Hayes, Chester, 1912. The mark is slightly rubbed but still distinguishable. It is in very good condition for its age. There are no major damages and it displays beautifully. There are some faint internal surface marks and a few light surface marks and signs of use and age but nothing detrimental.
